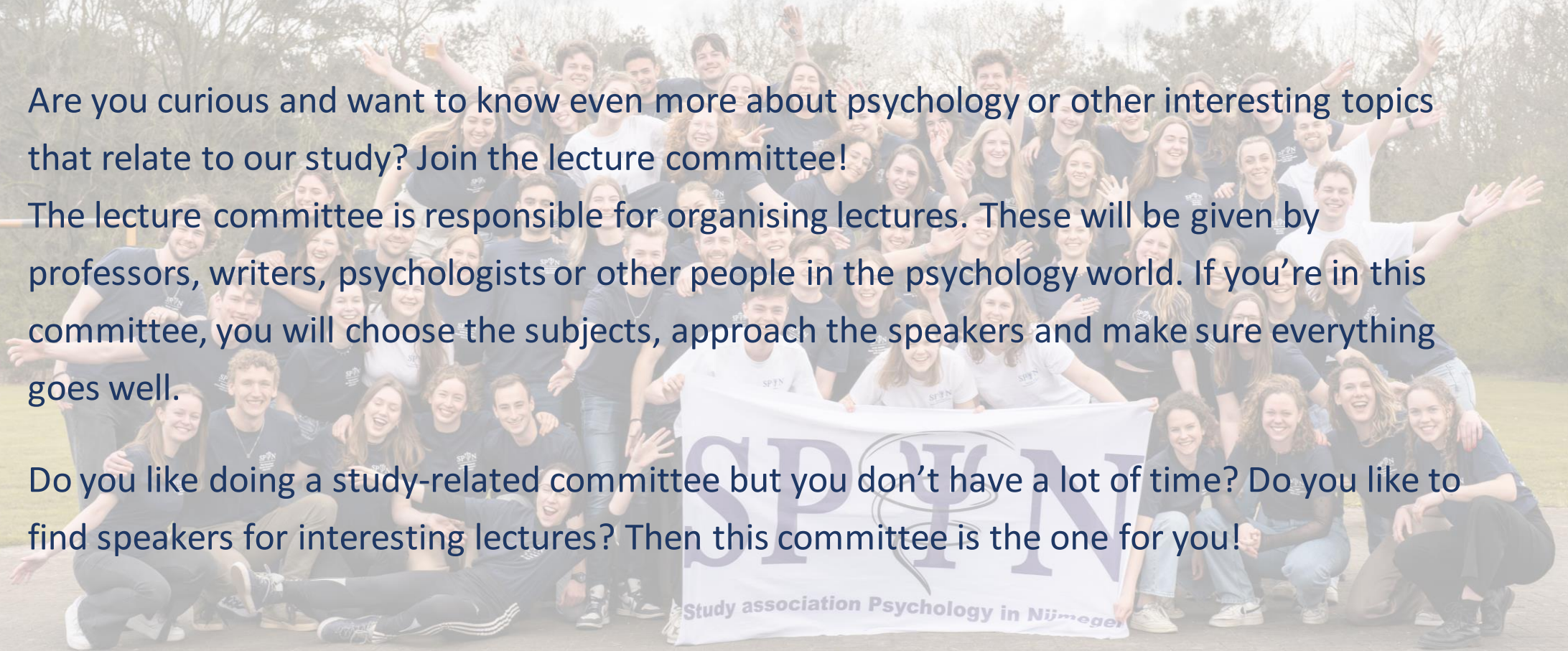


Lecture committee (1-2 hours a week)

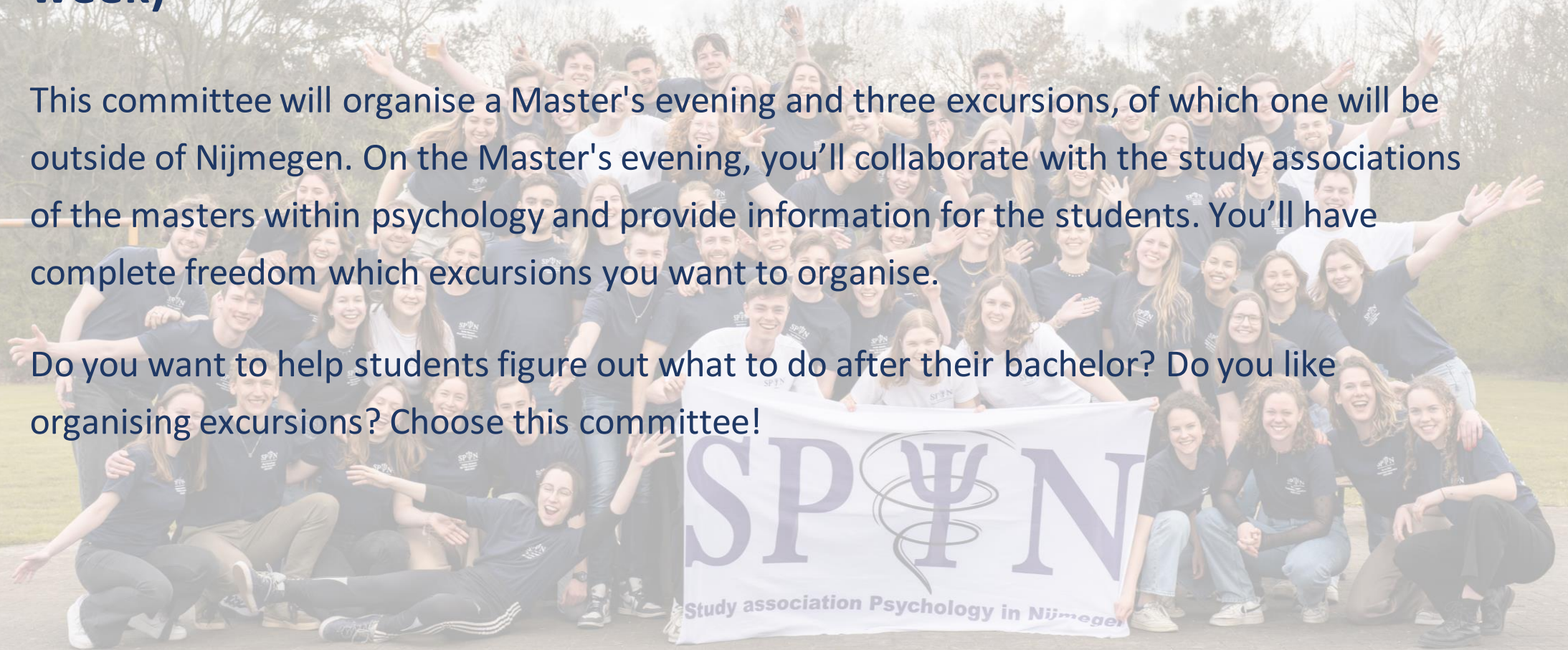
Do you want to inform SPiN-members and make them enthusiastic about different work fields? Do you see it as a challenge to make this event succeed? Then this committee should be yours!

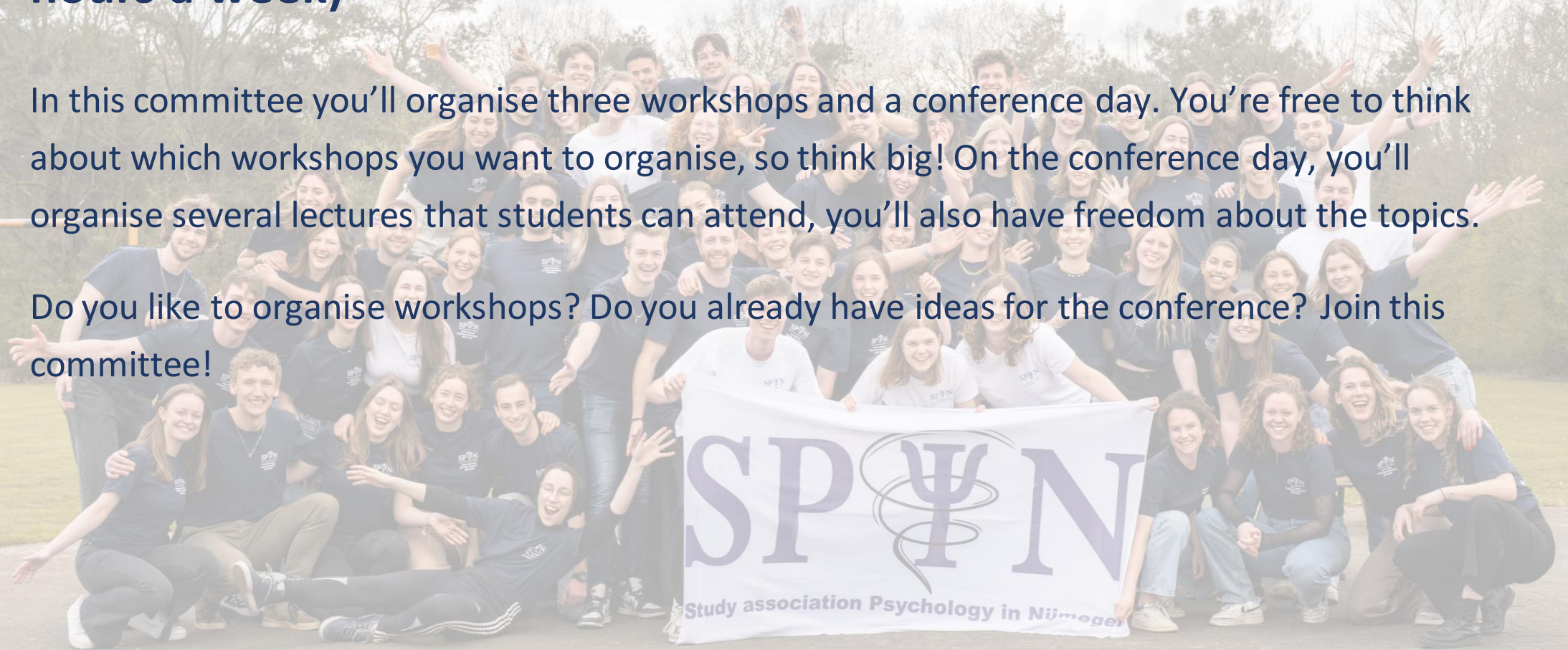
Do you want to help students figure out what to do after their bachelor? Do you like organising excursions? Choose this committee!

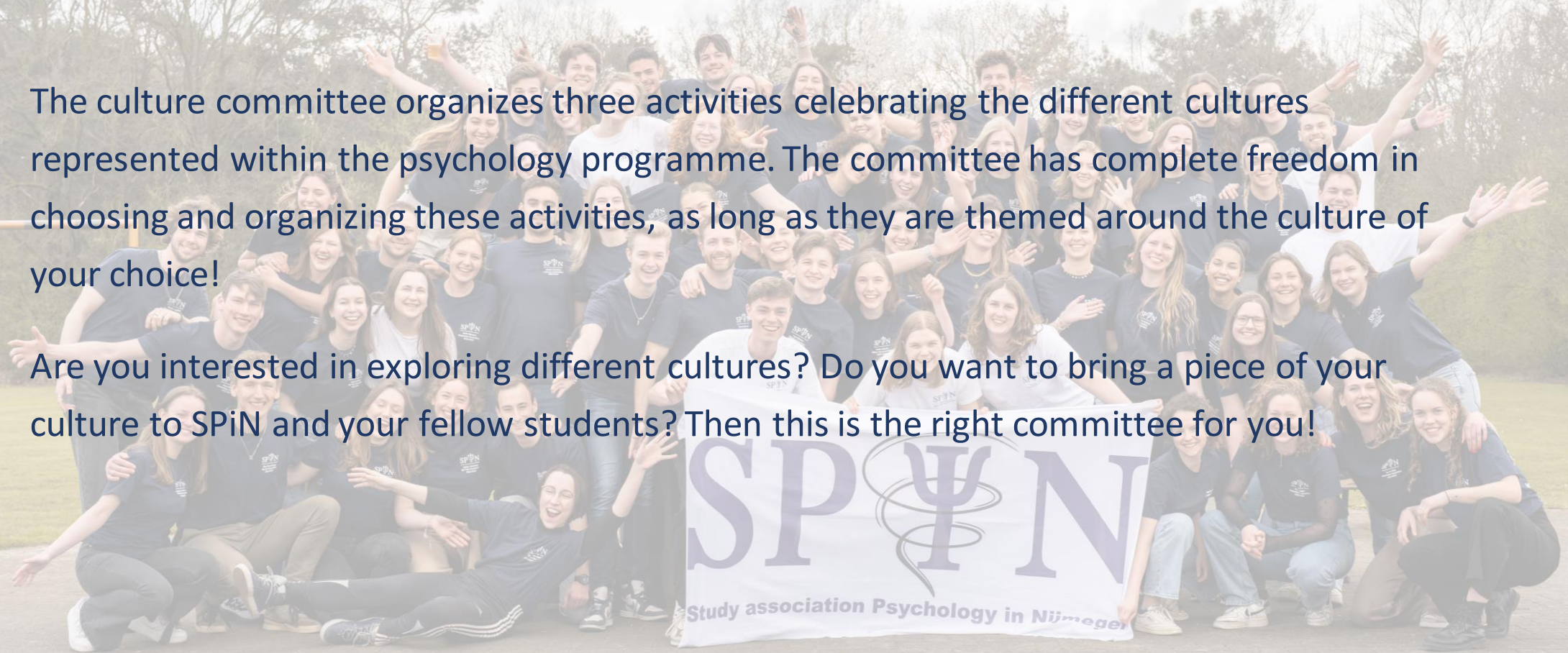
Do you like to organise workshops? Do you already have ideas for the conference? Join this committee!

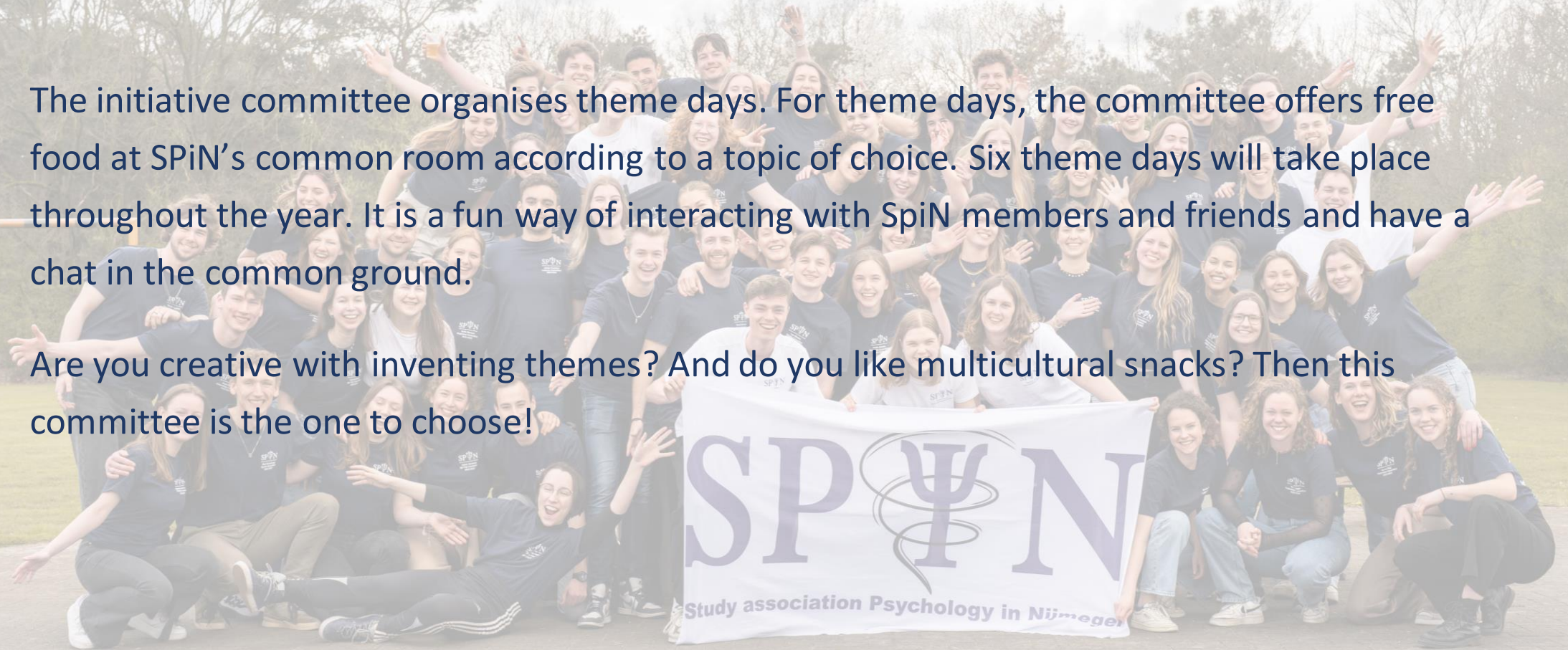
Are you interested in exploring different cultures? Do you want to bring a piece of your culture to SPiN and your fellow students? Then this is the right committee for you!

So, do you like parties? Are you not afraid to think outside the box? Then this committee will be the right fit for you!

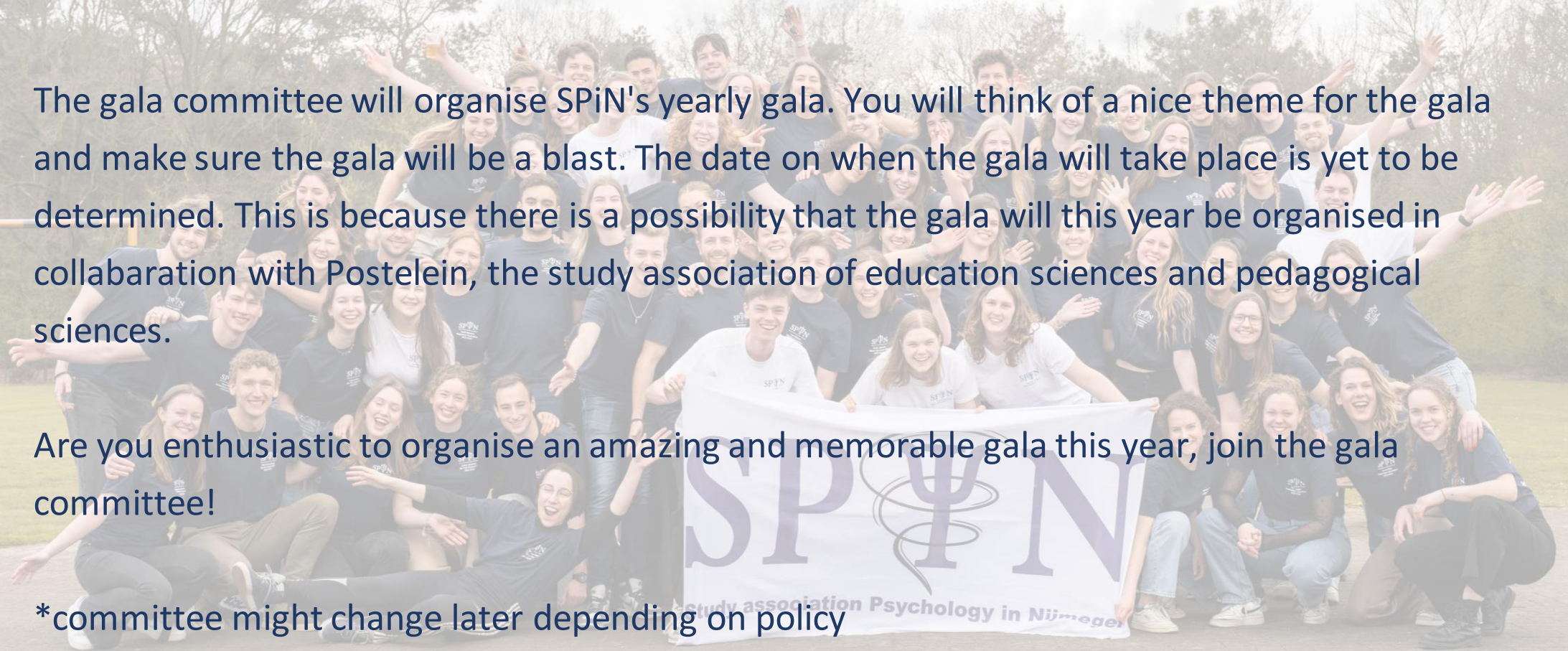


Gala committee* (1-2 hours a week)

Are you creative and want to organise fun activities for (new) members? The Social Activities committtee is the one for you!

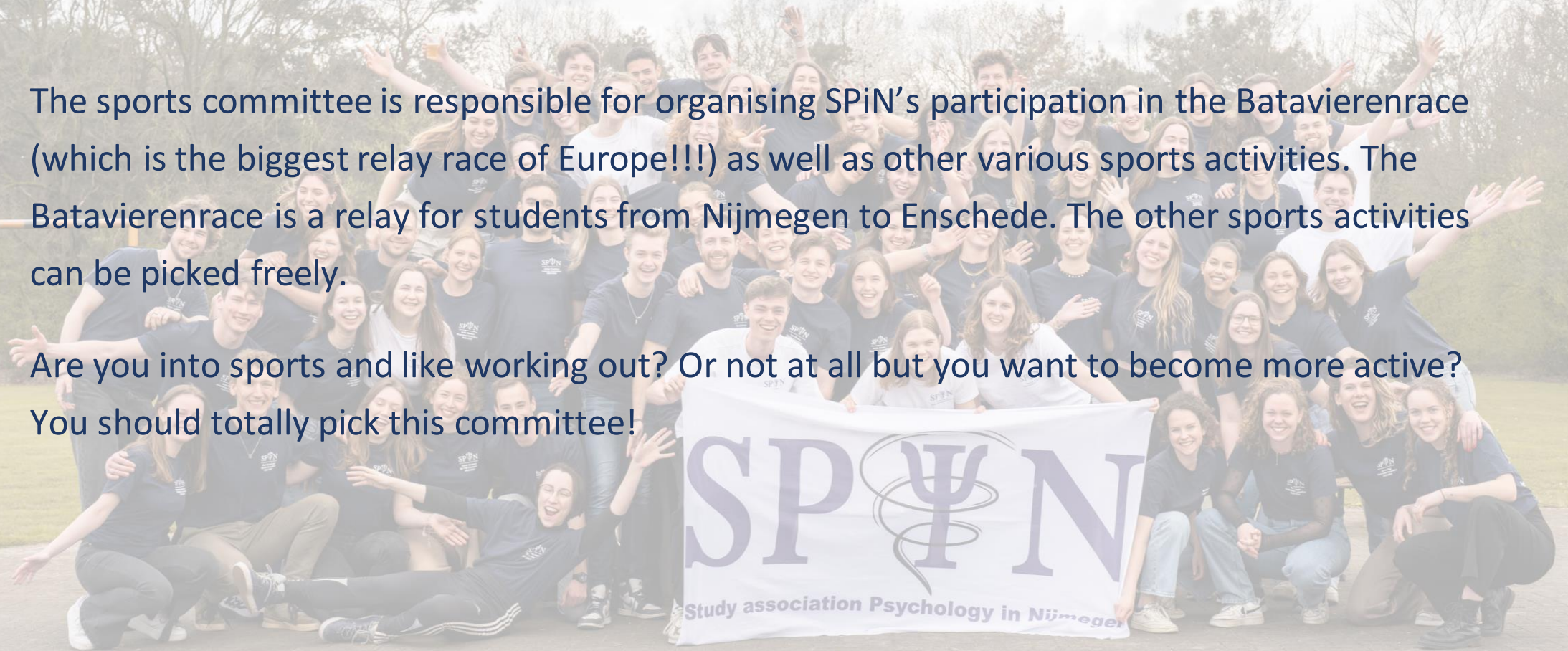
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Sports committee (1-2 hours a week)

Are you into sports and like working out? Or not at all but you want to become more active? You should totally pick this committee!

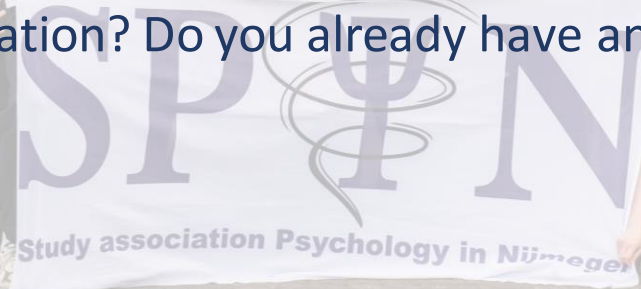


City trip committee (2-3 hours a week)

Do you like organising trips for the association? Do you already have an idea where you want to go? Choose this committee!

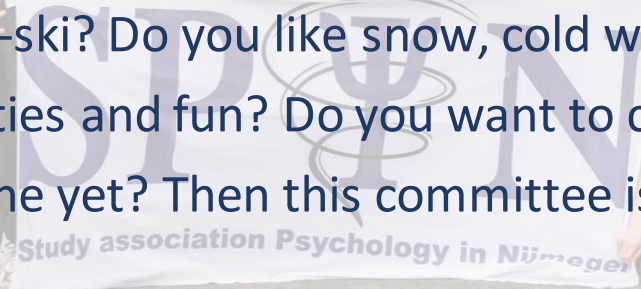


Ski trip committee (1-2 hours a week)

Do you like to take photos with a professional camera? Are you a social media expert? Then this committee is the right fit for you!

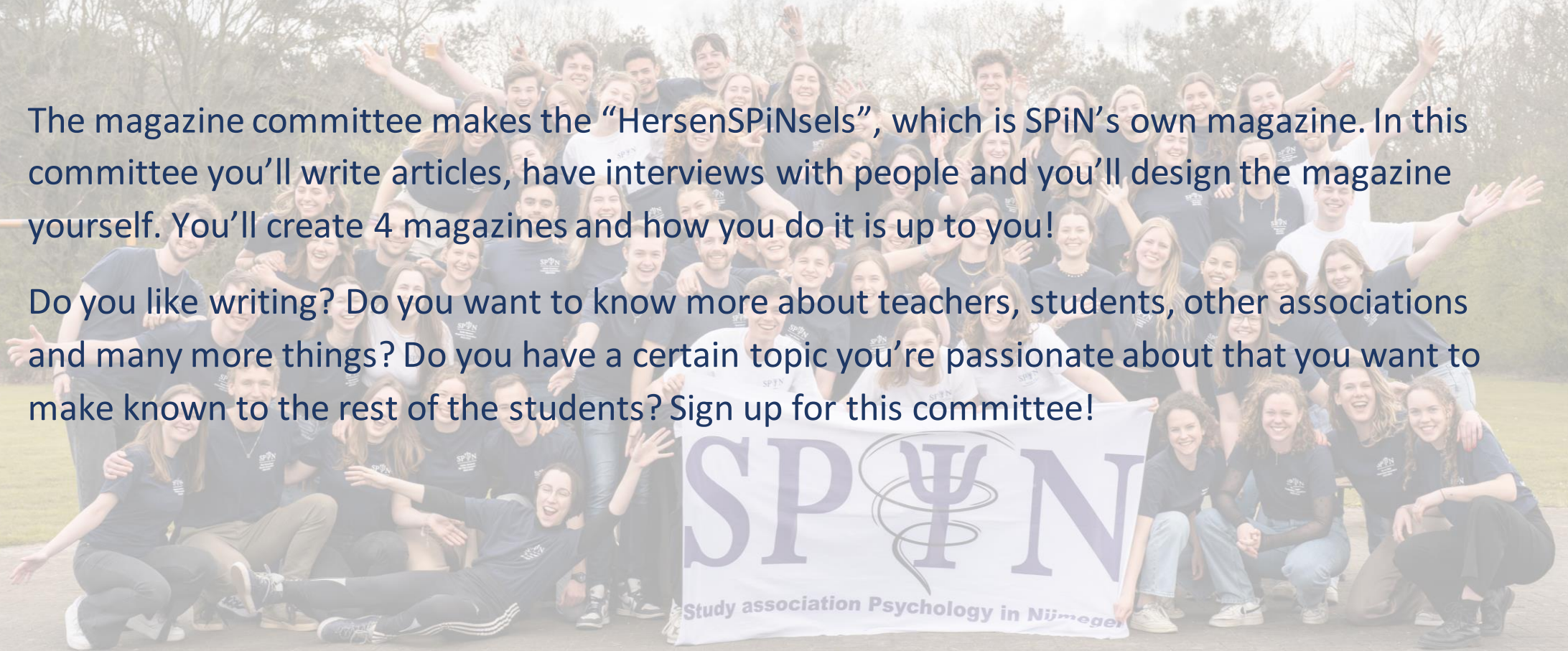

Would you like to improve your networking abilities? Are you creative with ideas for finding new sponsors? Are you willing to take on a challenge? Then choose this committee!

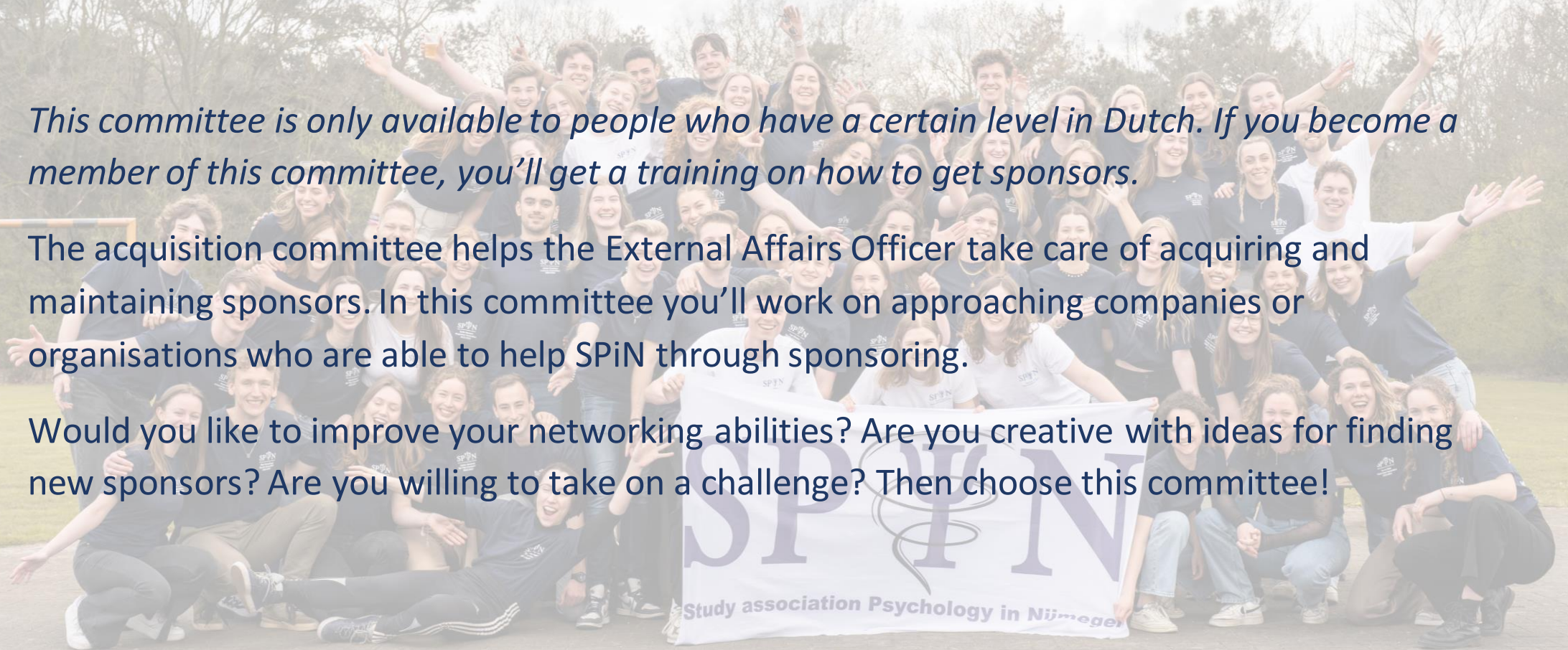


Illustration committee (1-2 hours per week)
